**Thomas G. Weiss** is Presidential Professor at the CUNY Graduate Center in New York and currently Visiting Professor at the Leuven Centre for Global Governance Studies, KU Leuven. He was President (2009-10) of the International Studies Association, and Chair (2006-9) of the Academic Council on the UN System (ACUNS). He recently published What's Wrong with the United Nations and How to Fix It (2nd ed. 2012) and Humanitarian

Business (January 2013). In his lecture, Professor Weiss will present the main ideas of his recent book Humanitarian Business, in which he analyses the 'humanitarian marketplace' of aid agencies which operate side-by-side with for-profit businesses, including private military and security companies, in an attempt to provide humanitarian aid to the millions of people living under duress.



Antoine Gérard is Head of the UN–OCHA Liaison Office in Brussels. From June 2006 to April 2009, he was UN-OCHA Deputy Head of Office and Darfur manager in Sudan. He has a long history of working with humanitarian organisations in numerous crisis situations. Mr. Gérard holds an advanced degree in Arabic Language and Middle Eastern studies from the French National Institute for Oriental Languages and Civilizations.
