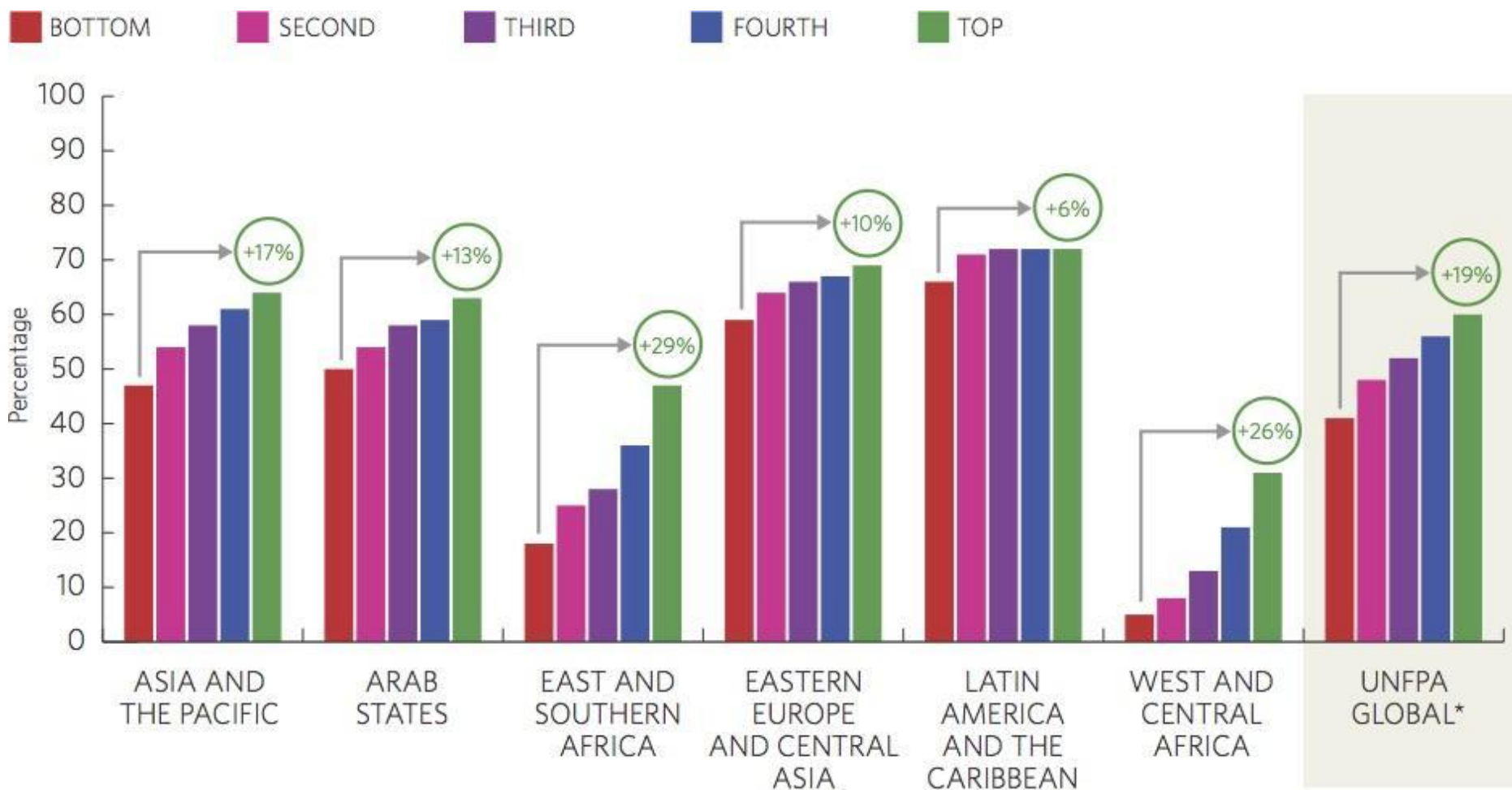

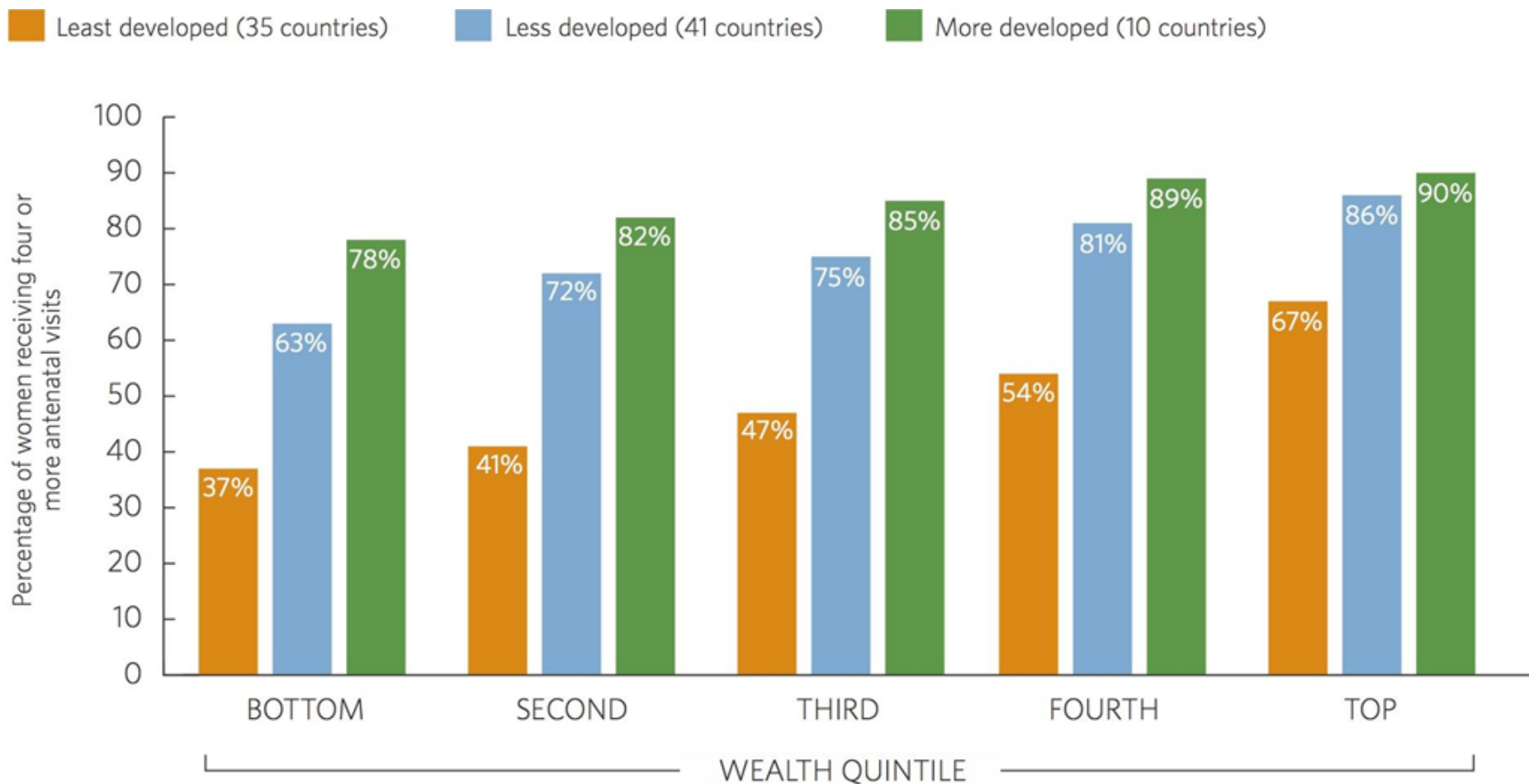
Contraception

Contraceptive prevalence rates among women aged 15 to 49 who are married or in a union, by region and wealth quintile



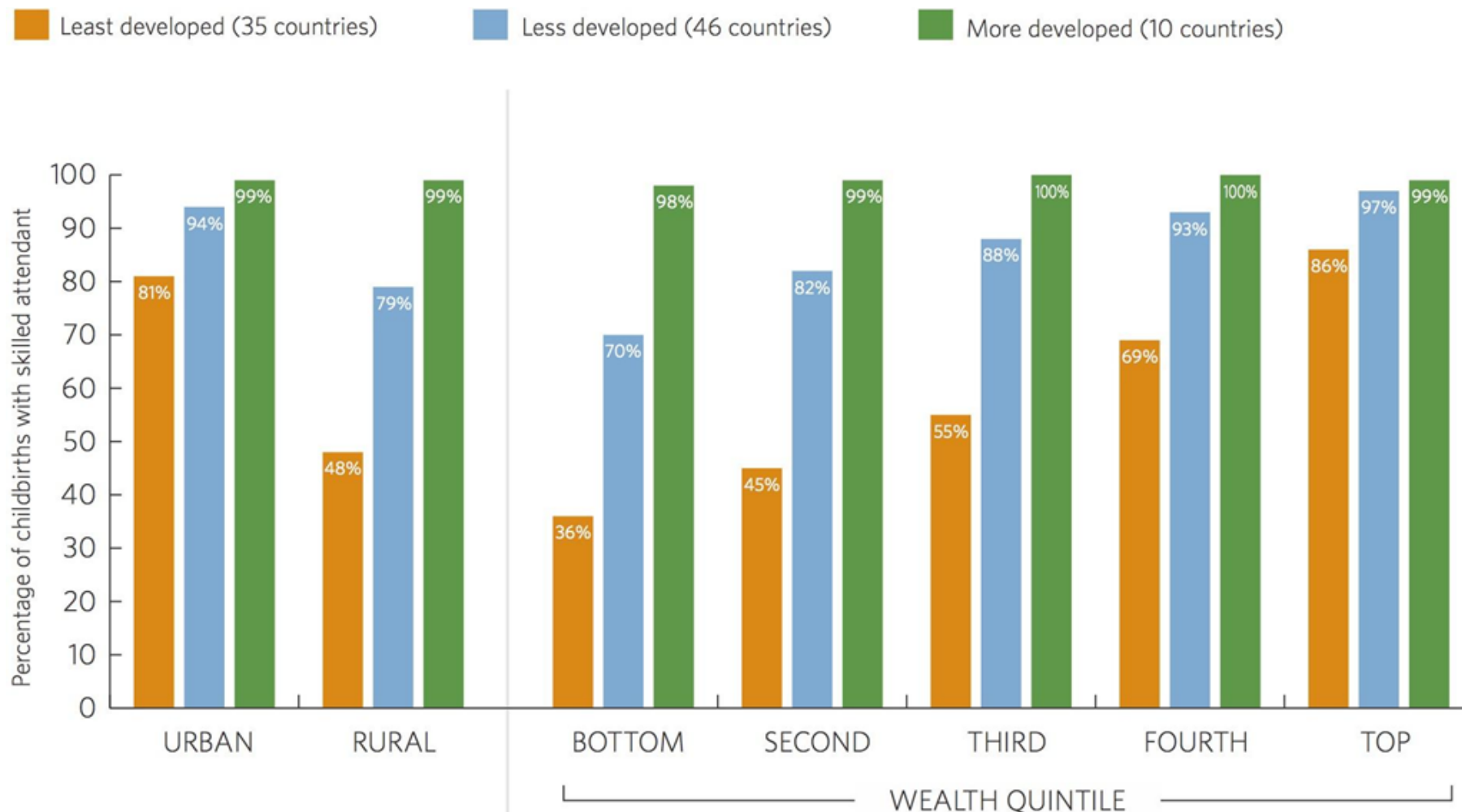
Antenatal care

Proportion of births with skilled attendants, by development category, place of residence and wealth quintile, latest year available





Inequality and sexual and reproductive health

- Limited access to services and poor health correlate with poverty.
- Lack of high-quality services blocks opportunities



Motherhood penalty

- Pregnancy and caring for children can exclude women from the paid labour force
- Working mothers earn less



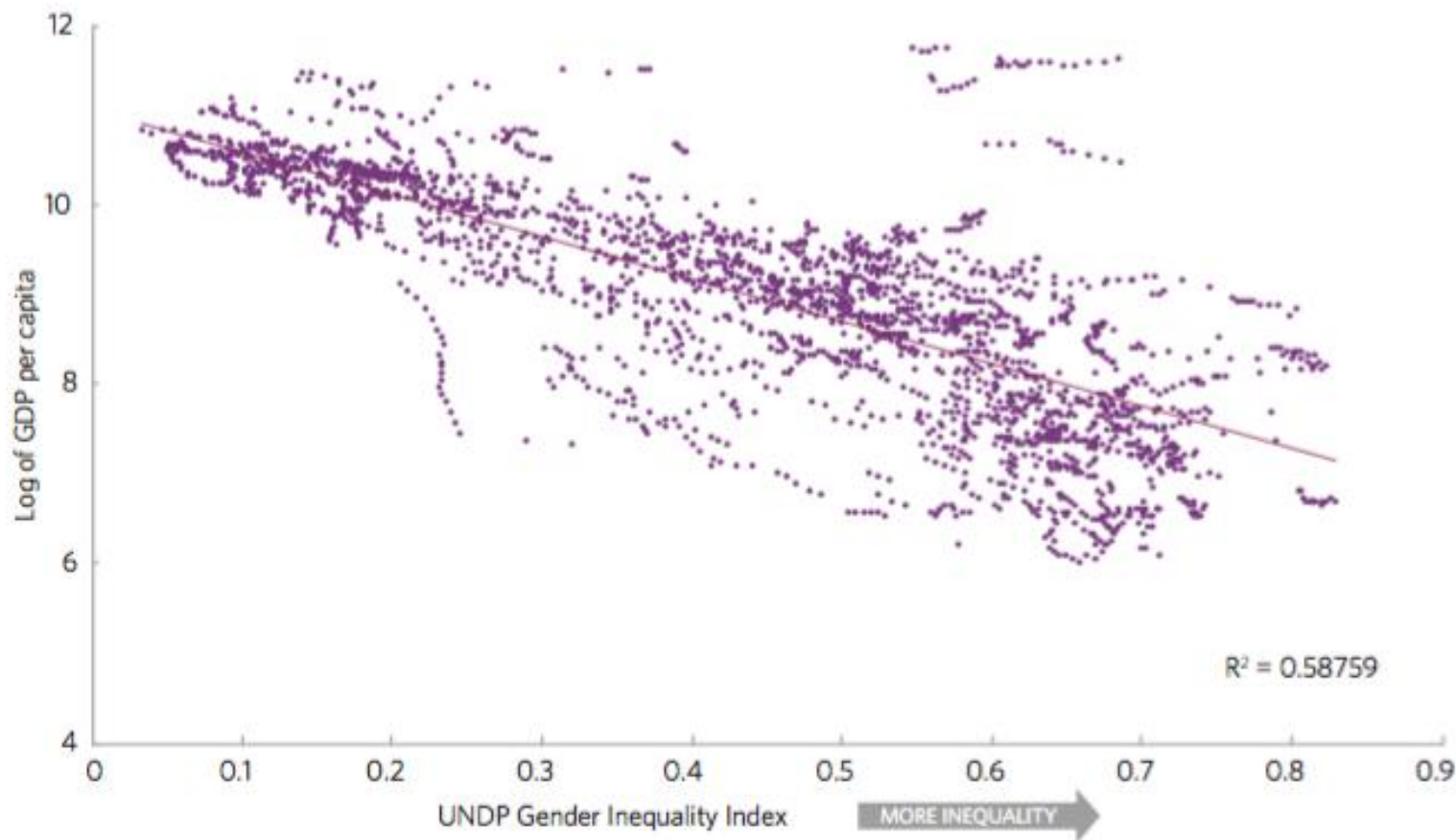
Underlying gender inequality



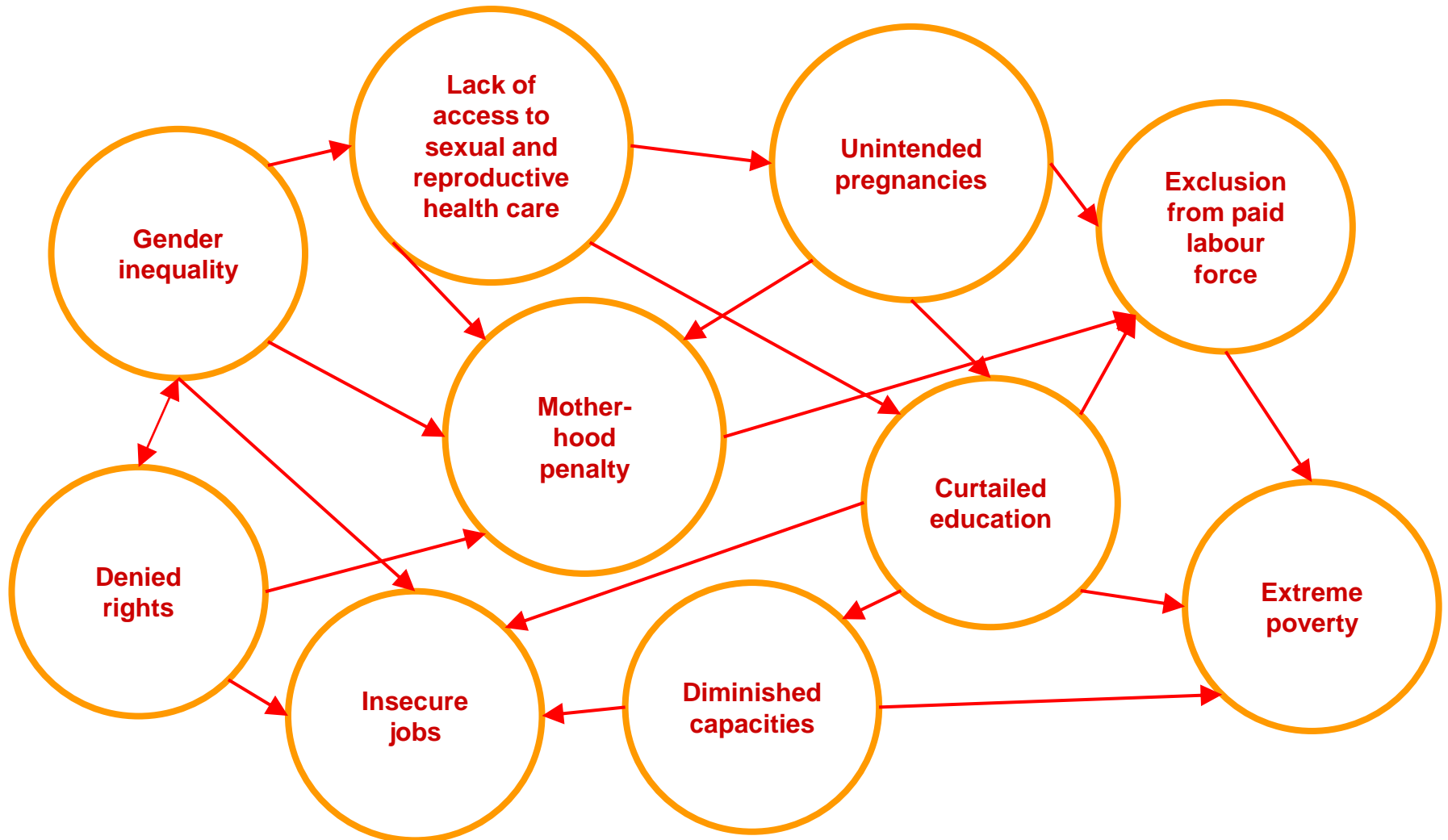

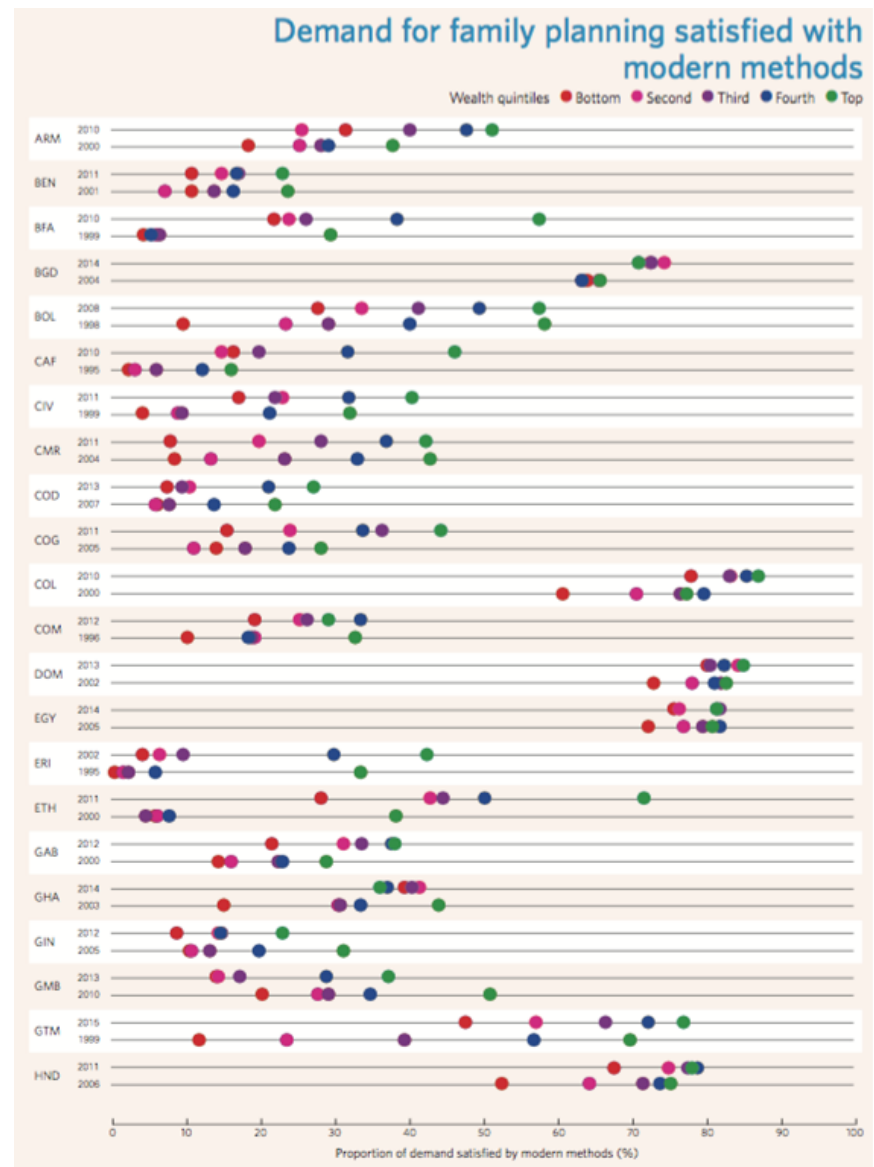
